### How:

The concept of a community school museum allows the students the possibility to introduce their personal story into school life.

### Advantages:

- By building a community school museum, students can track back the history of the local community and/or family and link it to the school.
- The use of a community school museum is the enhancement of the social cohesion at school and the empowerment of the student.
- The community school museum helps language poor or non-native students to bridge the gap between their personal background and the average school situation.
- The community school museum can help to overcome tensions between groups of students and understand how enemy images can develop.

### Goals of this course:

- Gaining insight in the use of a community school museum;
- Being able to use the concept of community school museum to enhance the social cohesion and intercultural dialogue at the school;
- Being able to use the concept of community school museum to include the personal, familial or cultural history of the students into the school's education context.
